Enrolment

Enrolling is free and voluntary. If you choose not to enrol you can still receive health care services from your chosen GP, general practice or primary health care services provider.

Appointments

Every effort will be made to accomodate your preffered time. However, emergencies will always be given priority.

Our reception staff will attempt to contact you if there are any unforeseen delays or if your GP has been called away.

Longer consultation times are available.

Payments

Fees are payable at the time of consultation.

We encourage prompt payment of fees.

We accept cash, eftpos, visa, mastercard and online payments. Paywave is also now available.

Some fees for enrolled and registered patients are subsidized by the Government.

Repeat Prescriptions

We are happy to issue repeat prescriptions. However, we ask that you give us as much advance notice as possible — 48 hours' warning being the minimum.

Repeat prescriptions do incur a charge and the doctor may need to see you prior to issuing for clinical and/or legal reasons — especially if you are not seeing your regular GP.
